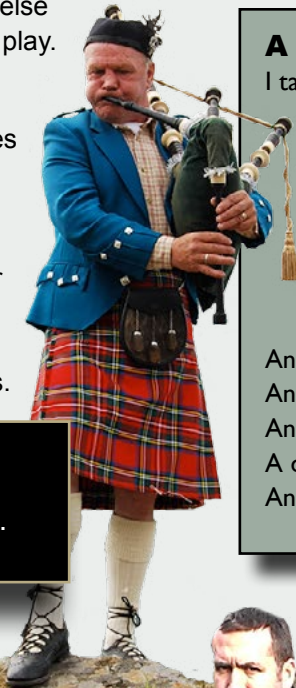

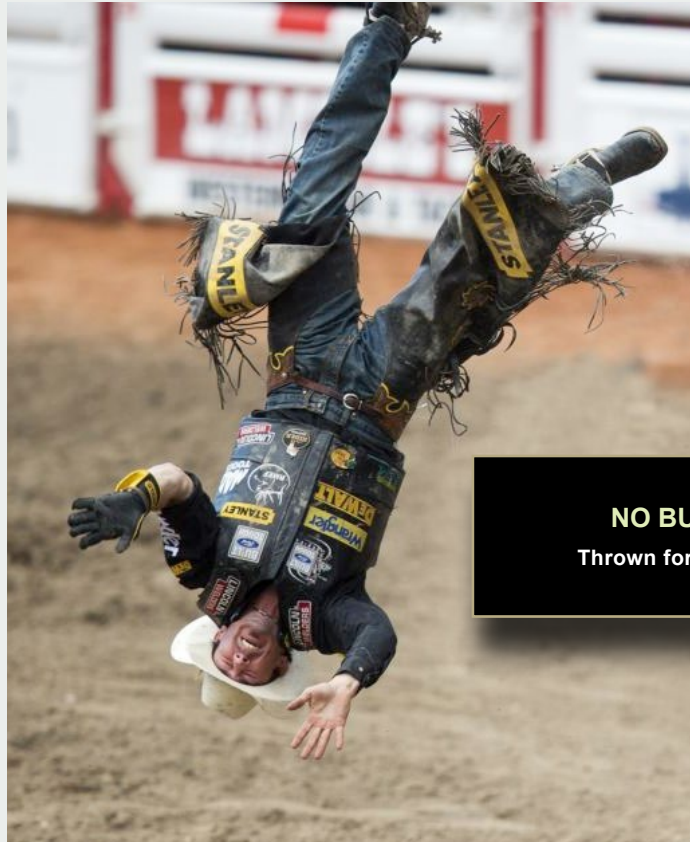

## DRINK TO ME ONLY WITH THINE EYES

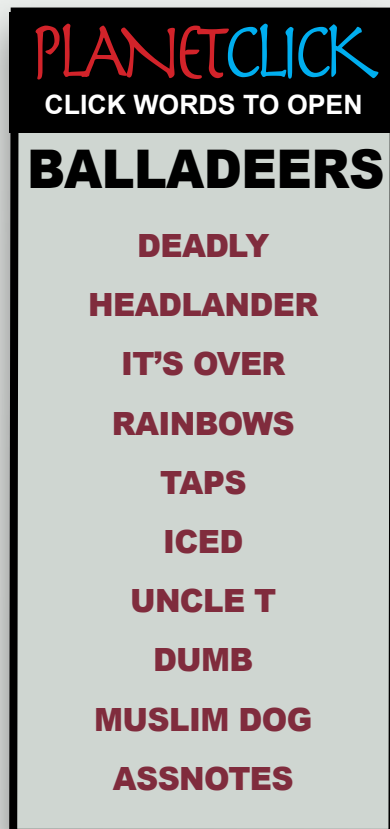
